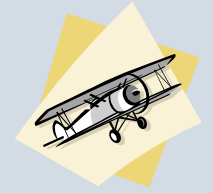

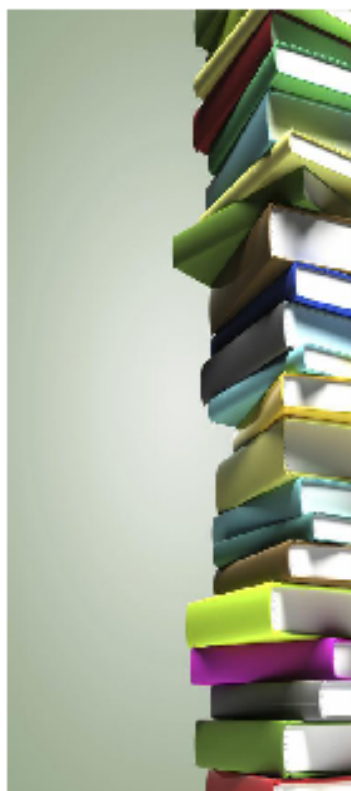

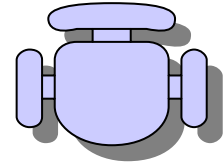

# FROM THE CHAIR

The weather has managed to stay very nice for the month of December. The up and down temperatures have made the roads a little icy and have made people more susceptible to obtaining a cold, but overall the Christmas season has been enjoyable.

The item for discussion this month is White Butte Regional Planning Committee. This group is formed of elected municipal council members from the Town of Balgonie, Town of White City, Town of Pilot Butte, Village of Edenwold and the RM of Edenwold. The committee contains two members from each municipality from their elected council and we have representation from the City of Regina and Regina Regional Opportunities Planning Commission.

The committee was formed in June 2008 and for the first 6 months the meetings were held on a rotating basis within the four communities (original group). The structure was very loose and the common concern at the time was the degradation of service and flow of traffic on the number one highway. From this common concern the founding municipalities determined that there may be enough common ground within the four municipalities to formalize the arrangement under which we had been meeting. Regina Regional Opportunities Commission provided some assistance and funding toward hiring a consultant to perform some workshops and determine if there was indeed enough interest from all the councils to formalize the arrangement. Through that series of workshops in late 2008 and early 2009 it was determined that enough commonality and potential for joint partnerships existed that in June 2009 a formal agreement to create the White Butte Regional Planning Commission was signed.

The committee was able to get the attention of the Ministry of Highways to create a functional group to study the conditions on the number one highway from the RM border on the west to number ten highway overpass. The study period was September 2009 to October 2010. There were numerous workshops held within the various municipalities, open houses to consult on designs and consultation with each municipality and business communities. The end result was a final report issued in November 2011 which was presented to the Minister for Highways and Infrastructure. The proposal was endorsed

by the Minister and some of the initial recommendations for deceleration and acceleration lanes at the locations chosen for interchanges were announced by the Minister to proceed to functional design and construction. The functional designs were carried out from January to April 2011 and approval was provided for those designs. The tenders were issued and construction started in September that carried on until freeze up. We are hoping to hear about the next stages of what will be constructed in the early part of 2012.

The White Butte Regional Planning Commission has expanded and now includes the Village of Edenwold. The committee was able to submit a proposal to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and obtained funding under the Planning for Growth initiative. This funding is providing the opportunity for the committee to explore further opportunities for joint partnerships on items such as recreation, fire protection, bylaw enforcement, bylaw standardization, and tenders for materials, education and infrastructure. The subcommittees have all been created and the group is working on the identity creation and a rollout of a website to provide information to the ratepayers from each member municipality. We are targeting to have the website up and running early in 2012 and information from each subcommittee will be available for viewing. This committee will continue to work on areas of joint interest and areas where potential cost savings can be achieved. ## Trimming Down on Holiday Waste!

Garbage Pick up will occur as Regularly Scheduled for Tuesday, December 27, 2011 in the Town of Balgonie.

## SNOW REMOVAL:

It is important that our graders have access to the entire street after a snow fall. Vehicles can only be parked on the street for 24 hours. And it is illegal to park an unlicensed vehicle on the street.

**After a snowfall, please remove your vehicle from the street, until your street has been cleared.**



### **Outstanding Utility Bills:**

Past Due Notices have been sent to all accounts that are outstanding. A 2% penalty is added to all utility bills after the end of every month. All outstanding amounts as of January 1, 2012 will then be applied to taxes. Once they have been transferred, a 1.5% penalty will be calculated each and every month thereafter.

***All customers with outstanding bills are requested to pay these amounts promptly .***

### **Penalties for Taxes**

The calculation for tax arrears penalties has changed from 2011 to 2012. In 2012, all tax arrears from 2011 (including utilities) will be penalized 1.5% each and every month on the total amount owing.

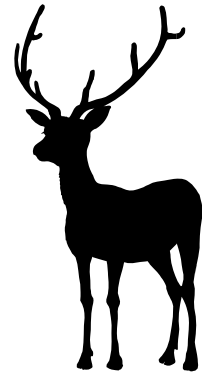

## GOD LAUGHED!

A young woman entered life in a convent as a novice nun. In this particular order all of the nuns took a vow of silence and were only allowed to speak two words to the Reverend Mother every 5 years. After 5 years the young nun went to see the Reverend Mother. The Reverend Mother said to her, "Sister, you have been in the order for five years now and have fulfilled all your vows admirably. You may now, if you wish, say the two words you are permitted to say. Without hesitation the nun responded. "So bad," she said. The Reverend Mother dismissed the novice saying that she would speak with her again in 5 years time. Again 5 years elapsed and the nun, now a little older and wiser, met with the Reverend Mother. "Not happy," were the 2 words she spoke, and then she began another five years of silence. Five years later the sister entered the Reverend Mother's office and said two words, "I Quit!"

"I'm not surprised." replied the Reverend Mother, "you've done nothing but complain about the place for the last 15 years!"

Most of us aren't even aware of how much humour there is in the Bible. We don't expect to find humour in a religious book, so we miss the joke completely when we read it. There's the story of the slick and crafty Jacob tricking his slow-witted Neanderthal older brother out of his inheritance. He dresses himself in hairy animal skins to trick his father, who is blind, into thinking he is his older brother. This would have been seen as hilarious by the early Jewish community.

Then there's the story of Jonah, the reluctant prophet, who turns tail at the first sign of trouble and runs. He is sent to the city of Nineveh to preach repentance to its citizens and urge them to turn away from their sins. No one is more surprised than Jonah when people actually listen to him and repent. Jonah doesn't believe this can happen, so he sits in the hot sun all day long looking over the city waiting stubbornly for the people to fall off the "repentance" wagon. This is classic comedy.

The 70 something year-old Sarah breaks into hysterical laughter when she is told that she is about to have a baby- wouldn't you?? In the end, the joke is on her!

I don't think I'm being too simplistic when I say that God wants to give all people everywhere Joy. *That is the Bible in a nutshell.* The wonderful Christmas joy that we experience in our celebration of Christ's coming into the world is really a preview of the kind of world that God wants to give us. God wants *all* people *everywhere* to be able to enjoy the abundant gifts of creation that we have all been given -not just the privileged and well off people of the world.

Laughter is healing. It helps us to forget ourselves. It gives us unexpected strength, and sometimes helps us over the mountains we thought we couldn't climb. It heals the spirit, the mind and the body. Nothing can bring people together faster than shared laughter. Laughter- Joy- is integrally, quintessentially a part of, and inseparable from, what it means to be a Christian.

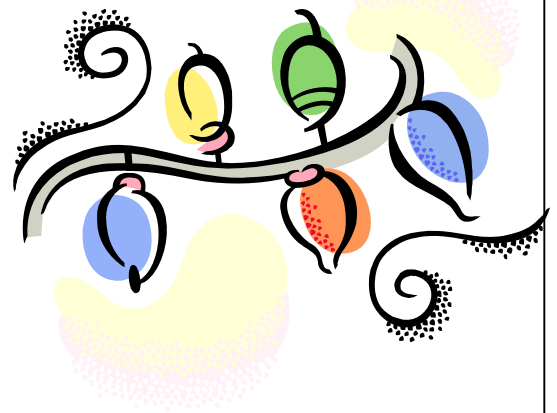

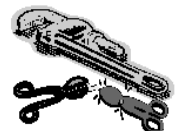
